

Lewis-McChord Free Press was a New Left student activist group made up of soldiers from the GI Alliance, and their underground newspapers were the main source of correspondence to other members. During the early 70s, the desertion and AWOL rates in the Army were the highest in modern history, with 7 desertions, 17 AWOL cases, 2 disciplinary discharges, 12 complaints to Congressmen, and 18 non-judicial punishments in every group of 100 soldiers, while almost a third reported some form of consistent drug use. The desertion rates in the Air Force, with the air war in Cambodia, increased by 300% from their 1968 levels. These newspapers are a detailed account of the culmination of that dissent.
